NEWS & ANNOUNCEMENTS

SUNDAY OF ORTHODOXY: We invite everyone to participate in the procession with the holy icons at the end of the Divine Liturgy. As it is customary in most parishes, we will read the special office celebrating the Triumph of Orthodoxy at the end of the procession. As you are able, please bring one icon from home.

CONFESSION: It is important that every Orthodox Christian receives the Mystery of Confession during the Lenten season. In the coming weeks, Fr. Alessandro will be available for Confession after the Liturgy of the Presanctified, after Great Vespers (Sat), or by appointment. If you wish to come before these services, please let him know ahead of time. Please, note that Friday, April 26 is the last day when Fr. Alessandro will hear Confessions before Pascha. When we enter Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, our focus must be exclusively on walking with our Lord through His passion.

PRESENTATION ON PROJECT MEXICO: This coming Sunday, during coffee hour, our parishioner Nicholas Barr will offer a presentation on his experience with Project Mexico last year, where he plans to work again next summer.

FASTING BEFORE PRESANCTIFIED: Since we serve the Liturgy of the Presanctified in the evening, Fr. Alessandro blesses to begin fasting immediately after lunch. To the best of our abilities, we should try to have an early lunch in preparation of receiving the Holy Eucharist later. If you have particular medical condition for which this seems impossible, please reach out to Fr. A.

POST-PRESANCTIFIED POTLUCKS: As it is customary in many Orthodox communities, we will share a lenten meal following the Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts. Please, feel free to bring (but not mandatory), a lenten dish or side to share.
